Extended abstracts should be at least two pages (A4 or Letter) in length, either in plain ASCII text, MS Word or Adobe PDF. A template for abstracts or papers is available on the web page www.wwrf37.ch. Full papers must be prepared using the WWRF template, available on the web page and may be submitted for publication in the meeting proceedings in
